Library account and support

Library account

To use the library, it is important to have a library account.

When registering, please fill in your personal details and do not forget to add a private e-mail address to your SWITCH edu-ID account. The HSLU card can be used as a library card number. <u>Instructions</u>.

If you completed the onboarding process, you already have a SWITCH edu-ID which is needed for registration. If you have not yet completed the process, please do that first: <u>https://account-onboarding.hslu.ch/en</u>

With the onboarding process, the L-number of your HSLU card will be added to your SWITCH account and automatically will appear in your library account.

Our library is one of about 500 Swiss libraries which are part of SLSP (Swiss Library Service Platform) - the Swiss network of academic libraries. The library account allows you to loan physical items from all the participating libraries, the whole stock from SLSP can be searched in <u>swisscovery</u>.


Our support services

Opening hours and workplaces



The opening hours of our info desk are Monday to Friday from 09:00-17:00. At lunchtime (12:00-13:00) the info desk is not staffed continuously.

The building, including the library, is accessible 24/7 with your HSLU Card as Student from the Lucerne School of Computer Science and Information Technology and the Lucerne School of Business.

The library is located on the entire third floor of House B, with workplaces reserved for quiet study. Various forms of workplaces are available: large tables, sofa corner, but also window seats and standing places.

The library does not offer places for group work!

It is possible to work in front of the library in the break area or outside lunchtime in House B in the self-catering area (2nd floor) or in the bistro (Ground floor).

For our students the walk-in space on the 2nd floor (House A) and the project workplaces on the 4th floor (House B) are also available.

Copying/printing/scanning

On the 'railway station side' of the library there is a room with a multifunctional device called 'print_public_i'. There is a display on the device with QR codes for the printer instructions.

You will need a copy card with credit for all the services on the device. You can use your HSLU card as a copy card. If you are travelling without a card, you can go to the info desk. There is a station where you can load cash on your HSLU Card on the 2nd floor of House A.

You can save scanned documents on a USB stick or send them to yourself by e-mail.

Printing from a USB stick is possible, but the document must be either a PDF or a JPEG.

A mobile book scanner is available in the same copy room, which can be used without borrowing. Software must be installed to use the scanner; instructions are available in the scanner box.



Borrowing and returning items

Where can I find the book on the shelf?

Search through our library stock in swisscovery RZS - HSLU.

How to proceed? When searching for a specific book, you can, for example, search by title (without subtitle) and author (surname) or <u>ISBN</u>. If the book you are looking for does not appear directly in the hit list, you can refine the search using filters.

For general literature searches, please refer to the information in the relevant training courses.

In the screenshot below, the signature of the book is framed in red. The shelfmark is located on the spine of the book. It can be used to quickly find a book on the shelf.

Borrowing items

Borrowing an item at the self-service station.

Click on "Check-out" (or «Ausleihe» if the language is set to German) and scan in your HSLU-Card. Put the book on the plate. Check on the screen if the book is marked green. Click «Finished» at the bottom on the right side. You can choose whether you want to print a receipt or not.





Self-collect shelf for picking up items

As soon as ordered items arrive at the library, you are informed by email. They will be held for you on our collection shelf (right next to the self-checkout desk) for one week. The items on the collection shelf are organized alphabetically according to your surname, with the first four letters of your surname on the white label in the book.

You have to borrow the ordered item at the self-service station before leaving the library!

Loan periods/renewals/reminders and overdue notices

Regular loan period: 28 Days

DVDs/Blu-Rays/Games: 14 Days



If there are no reservations on the item or a block in your user account, the loan period is automatically extended by 28 days up to the maximum loan period of 168 days.

You can use your user account in swisscovery RZS - HSLU to check whether and until when the loan period has been automatically extended, and you can also renew items manually.

After a maximum of 168 days, the loan period cannot be extended any further; the item must be presented at the info desk. If it's not reserved, it can borrowed agan.

Reminder and fees after the loan period has expired:

Reminder: free of charge (on the 1st day after the due date)

- 1. overdue notice: CHF 5 per item (one week after the reminder letter)
- 2. overdue notice: additional CHF 5 per medium (one week after the 1st reminder)
- 3. overdue notice: an additional CHF 10 per medium (one week after the 2nd reminder)

The reminders are usually sent by e-mail. **Please check your user account in swisscovery RZS -HSLU after every end of the loan period to see whether it has really been extended!** It is possible that the e-mail is not delivered (e.g. spam).

Your user account will be automatically blocked after the 3rd reminder. If the items are not returned, they are considered lost (<u>with corresponding costs</u>).

Returning items

Items can be returned in three different ways. This applies to borrowed items from the library locations of the <u>ZHB Lucerne</u> including the HSLU libraries, as well as from the <u>Pädagogischen Medienzenzrum (PMZ)</u> and the <u>Cooperative Storage Library Switzerland</u> in Büron, regardless of where they were borrowed.

1) Via the book return box, which is located outside the library in building A. We empty this box two to three times a day during info desk opening hours.

2) Send it back by post (see website for address).

3) Or you can also return books at the info desk during our opening hours.



Request items and swisscovery RZS

swisscovery RZS

The stock (physical and electronic) of all <u>RZS libraries</u> are listed in swisscovery RZS. The Central Switzerland region (RZS) is a sub-network within SLSP.

How can I limit and filter my search results?

Use the advanced search in <u>rzs-hslu.swisscovery.org</u> to search only for English-language books containing the term 'Java' in the title, for example.

For Home Delivery by Post (CHF 12) and SLSP-Courier (CHF 6).

- **Local courier** Order items of the Central Switzerland region (RZS) from one library to another free of charge. For example, from the Library of Business in Lucerne to us in Rotkreuz. Delivery time: around two working days. <u>Libraries of the RZS</u>
- **SLSP-Courier** Order item from the Swiss Library Service Platform (SLSP) from one library to another for CHF 6. For example, from the Zentralbibliothek Zürich (ZB) to us in Rotkreuz. Delivery time: around three working days. <u>SLSP libraries</u>
- **Postal delivery** Order items for CHF 12 by post to your home or business address.

Using E-Resources

Access options E-Resources

The download options vary depending on the provider/platform.

E-resources licensed by the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts can be viewed in the HSLU network, on site in the WLAN or as a member of the Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts from home with the HSLU VPN access.

Instructions for installing and using the VPN can be found on the <u>Self Service-Portal</u> of the Service Desk IT Servies of the HSLU Services.

Usually the HSLU e-resources are available online without further login.


O'Reilly resources can only be read online with the SWITCH edu-ID of the HSLU, regardless of the network.
