# Organising your exchange semester

Students of the Lucerne School of Business have the possibility of studying for one or two semesters at a partner university abroad. We have more than 80 partnership agreements in Europe, Asia, America and Australia. Having international experience is important if you are planning to work in an international company or in a local company which does business abroad. Being linguistically and culturally competent will also help to improve your employability.

## What are the selection criteria?

Motivation, grades and language skills in the target language of your exchange semester are among the main selection criteria.

## How should you proceed?

- Read all of the information on the student platform ILIAS > Exchange Mobility.
- Attend the information session in autumn to clarify any questions you have.
- Fill in the exchange application and upload it with the required documents.

## What are the deadlines?

**15 February:** This deadline is for applications for an exchange in the following academic year.

**30 September:** This is an additional deadline for Master's students who are applying for an exchange place for the upcoming spring semester.

## What are the costs?

The total cost of an exchange semester varies depending on the destination. Please contact the Exchange Programme Team for more information.
